

Contact Lens Fitting Benefit

Superior Vision offers a **stand-alone Contact Lens Fitting (CLF) exam** benefit that leaves the member's full eyewear allowance available for use toward the cost of contact lenses.

Other vision companies deduct the cost of the CLF exam from the eyewear allowance leaving the member with a reduced allowance to purchase contact lenses.

Superior Vision's CLF benefit includes:

- **Standard CLF exam** covered in full, following applicable co-pays
 - This fitting is for an existing contact lens user who wears disposable, daily wear, or extended wear contact lenses. It includes two follow-up visits within three months
- **Specialty CLF exam** covered up to a \$50 retail allowance, following applicable co-pays
 - This fitting is for a member who has never worn contact lenses or who requires a more complex fit for toric, gas permeable, or multi-focal contact lenses. It includes two follow-up visits within three months

In addition:

- Members can receive a CLF exam and are not required to purchase contacts
- Following the CLF exam, members still have the choice to use their eyewear benefit for contact lenses or eyeglasses

Allowance is Meant for Contact Lenses

Comparison assumptions¹: Contact lens allowance = \$120; Standard CLF exam = \$70
